







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

Heritage Conservation at Parvati Hills

Parvati Hill is a hillock in Bibewadi in Pune. Atop the hillock is the Parvati Temple, one of the most scenic locations in Pune. The temple is the oldest heritage structure in Pune and was built during the rule of the Peshwa dynasty. Besides the temple, the Peshwa Museum is situated there. The museum houses the weaponry, coins, utensils, wooden furniture, modes of transport (palanquin) and gifts acquired from the times of the Peshwas.

On the 31st of January 2022, the NSS unit at Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Engineering for Women in Pune took the initiative to conserve this historical landmark by cleaning its environs and educating people about the necessity of preserving these historical monuments.

Savitribai Phule Jayanti

Savitribai Phule is considered to be the pioneer of India's feminist movement. Savitribai and her husband founded one of the first modern Indian girl's school in Pune, at Bhide wada in 1848. She worked to abolish the discrimination and unfair treatment of people based on caste and gender. She is regarded as an important figure of the social reform movement in Maharashtra.

On the occasion of Birth anniversary of Savitribai Phule, on 3 rd of January the NSS unit at Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Engineering for Women in Pune held a program celebrating her life. This program was attended enthusiastically by the Principal Dr. S. R. Patil, NSS Officers Prof. S. A. Itkarkar and Prof. Dr. Sonali Kadam and volunteers.

Heritage Conservation at Sinhagad Fort

Sinhagad is a hill fortress located at around 49 km southwest of the city of Pune. Some of the information available about this fort, suggests that the fort could have been built 2000 years ago. Previously known as Kondhana, the fort had been the site of many battles, most notably the Battle of Sinhagad in 1670. This most famous battles on Sinhagad was fought by Tanaji Malusare, general of Shivaji Maharaj of the Maratha Empire in order to recapture the fort in March 1670.

On February 6, 2022, the NSS unit of Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Engineering for Women in Pune took the initiative to maintain this historical landmark by planting trees, cleaning the fort area, and participating in a few other activities. Cleanliness Drive, Swachhta, and Shramdaan efforts were carried out in the fort.

Women's Day




Tree plantation activity was held at Gorhe BK, Pune focusing on the concept of 'Nakshatravan' which 'Nakshatra' means star constellation and 'van' means forests, simply put together is Nakshatravan which is forming a garden or a forest with these trees associated with stars as per the Vedic astrology. A Nakshatra or lunar mansion is one of the 27 or 28 divisions of the sky that the Moon passes through during its monthly cycle, as used in Hindu astronomy and Hindu


astrology. Each Nakshatra is identified by its prominent star(s) and is associated with a Zodiac. Hindu astrologers believe that each constellation of the zodiac is associated with a tree. Those trees are of medicinal, social, aesthetic or economic value.

We planted saplings namely Kajra, Aavla, Vad, Sal, Phanas, Ambaa, Rue, Shaami, Umbar, Jambhul, Arjun, Surangi, Bel etc. In this tree plantation activity, Dr. S. R. Patil Sir (Principal), NSS program officers Prof. S. A. Itkarkar, Prof. Dr. Sonali P. Kadam, Dr. Deepali. A. Godse (H.O.D.
