NSS special Camp was held at Khopi, near Khed-Shivapur, Taluka-Haveli, Dist- Pune with around 70 volunteers participating enthusiastically in the same. Various programs were organized for the residents.

On 22nd January, the Inauguration Ceremony was held in the august presence of our respected Principal Prof. Dr. D. S. Bilgi, Sarpanch of Khopi Mr. K. A. Shivarkar, dignitaries, volunteers and staff members of BVCOEW. In the evening hours, a survey was conducted by the NSS volunteers where in they tried to understand the problems faced by the residents like school drop-outs and awareness among the people about tree plantation. On conclusion of the survey, based on the analysis, it was decided to distribute Neem and Curry saplings to the residents. The day concluded with, NSS volunteers analyzing the reasons for school dropouts and making plans to create awareness of education for them.

On 23rd January, "The Yogabhyas Shibir" was conducted by Yogacharya Mr. Amol Patil from Bharati Vidyapeeth's Ayurveda Hospital for local student and NSS volunteers. The purpose of the shibir was to know the importance of Yoga in our day to day life. Then there was "Kalopasna" conducted by Prof. Girish Charwad from Bharati Vidyapeeth's College of Fine Arts.
