





"The two-day seminar covered issues faced by transgenders today. We need to keep a different approach for new initiatives, as bringing them in the main stream society and their social acceptance is important. While interacting with transgenders we got to know that they can't get houses on rent despite having the money. Their health, education and other issues need to be discussed.





The organization of each and every event was proper and volunteers managed everything that came across the whole camp. Everyone learned many new things , innovations , made new friends and unity at its best .






