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





Institutional Initiatives for Electoral Literacy

 Whether Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) has been set up in the college. The Electoral Literacy club has been set up in the college. It is a platform for students to engage in various activities for spreading voter awareness and promoting voter literacy through it.Students are guided and provided information about electoral rights and familiarize them with the electoral process of registration and voting. The club will have the students from all the branches and all years as ELC member.

Vision: To enlighten, enable and empower every student as active citizen to register as a voter and cast his/her vote at every election in an informed and ethical manner.

Objectives of ELC:

1. To educate and encourage the targeted populations about voter registration electoral process and related practices through various activities.

2. To educate and familiarize about EVM and VVPAT and the robustness of EVM as well as the integrity of the electoral process using EVMs.

3. To help and understand the value of their vote and exercise their right to cast their vote in a confident, comfortable and ethical manner.

4. To encourage the ELC members for carrying electoral literacy in communities.5. To facilitate voter registration for all the eligible new voters who are not yet registered.

6. To develop a culture of electoral participation and maximize the informed and ethical voting and follow the principle of "every vote count" and "No voter left behind".

Different activities are carried out for the students under this club to strengthen the culture of electoral participation for the future voters.

Electoral literacy Club (ELC)

The committee is functional and conducts different activities as per the calendar decided at the start of the semister.

2. What innovative programmes and initiatives undertaken by the ELCs? These may include voluntary contribution by the students in electoral processes-participation in voter registration of students and communities where they come from, assisting district election administration in conduct of poll, voter awareness campaigns, promotion of ethical voting, enhancing participation of the under privileged sections of society especially transgender, commercial sex workers, disabled persons, senior citizens, etc.

The Different general initiatives carried out by the ELC are

- 1. Organizing the club enrollment.
- 2. Planning the activities and developing the calendar for the year.
- 3. Frame the guideline for smooth conduction of electoral activities.
- 4. Supervising the activities as per the calendar.
- 5. Generate the ELC resources.
- 6. Registration Facility is to be provided for newly eligible students.
- 7. Registering the students and communities for voter registration in their residential areas.
- 8. Participate in voter awareness program.
- Any socially relevant projects/initiatives taken by College in electoral related issues especially research projects, surveys, awareness drives, creating content, publications highlighting their contribution to advancing democratic values and participation in electoral processes, etc.

Many socially relevant projects were initiated by ELC in the electoral related issues such as, voting awareness program through rally held in nearby villages (Khopi and Shriramnagar) during residential NSS camp. This included spreading of social awareness in the above mentioned places with regards to ethical voting. Various drives were also undertaken in these villages as a measure of making the general public aware about their effective participation in the voting process. Extent of students above 18 years who are yet to be enrolled as voters in the electoral roll and efforts by ELCs as well as efforts by the College to institutionalize mechanisms to register eligible students as voters.

The efforts taken by the college is institutionalizing mechanism to regulate eligible students as voters involved. Collaboration between the Honorable District Magistrate of Pune and the college was carried out in order to conduct the enrolment of the students who are 18 years and above age.
