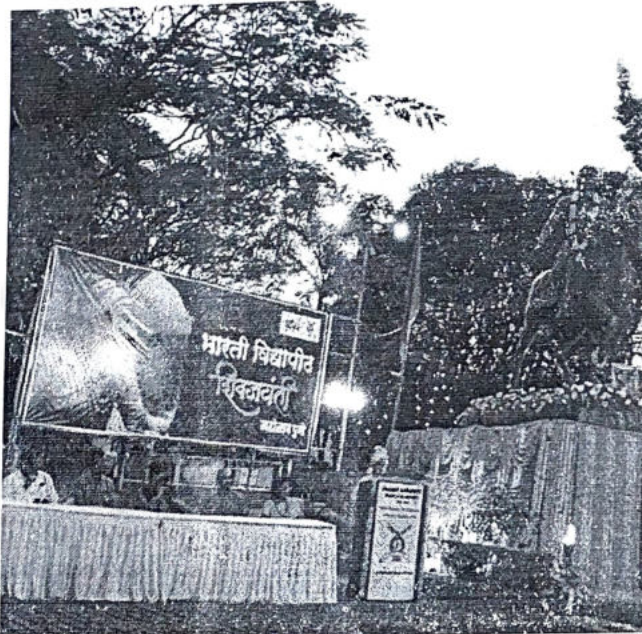

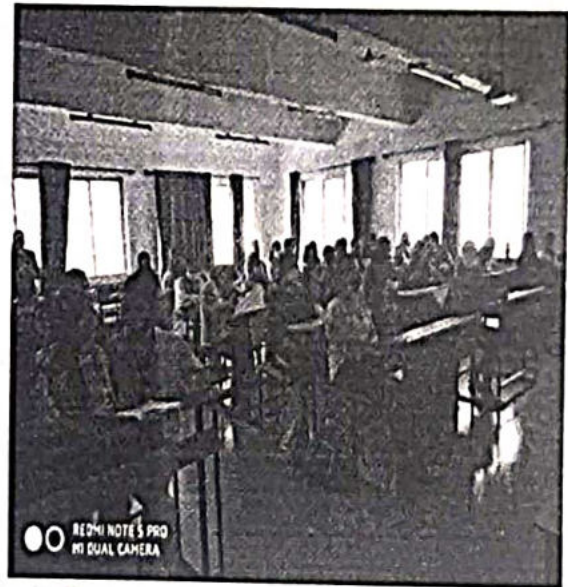

Students performed various activities like speech, poem reading, singing in Marathi bhasha.

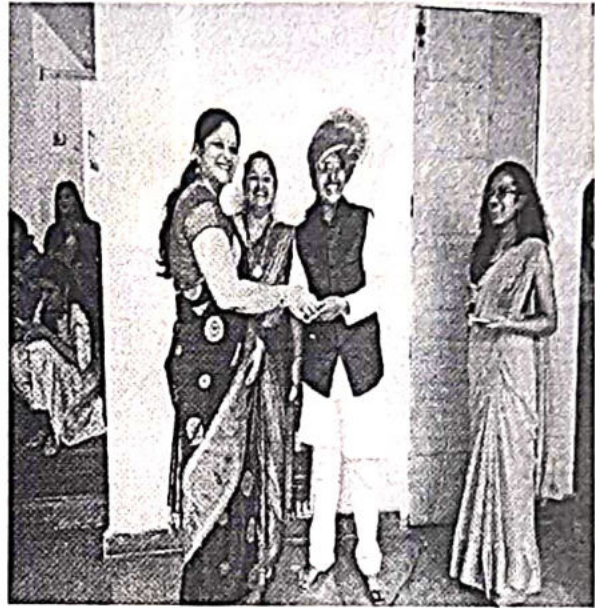


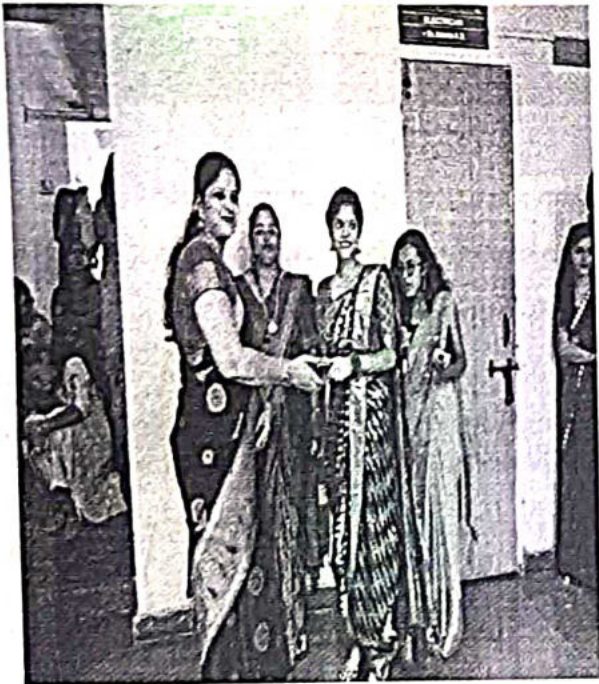
