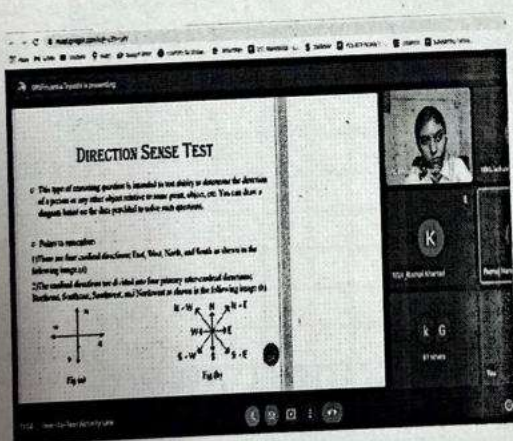

PEER TO PEER TRAINING REPORT

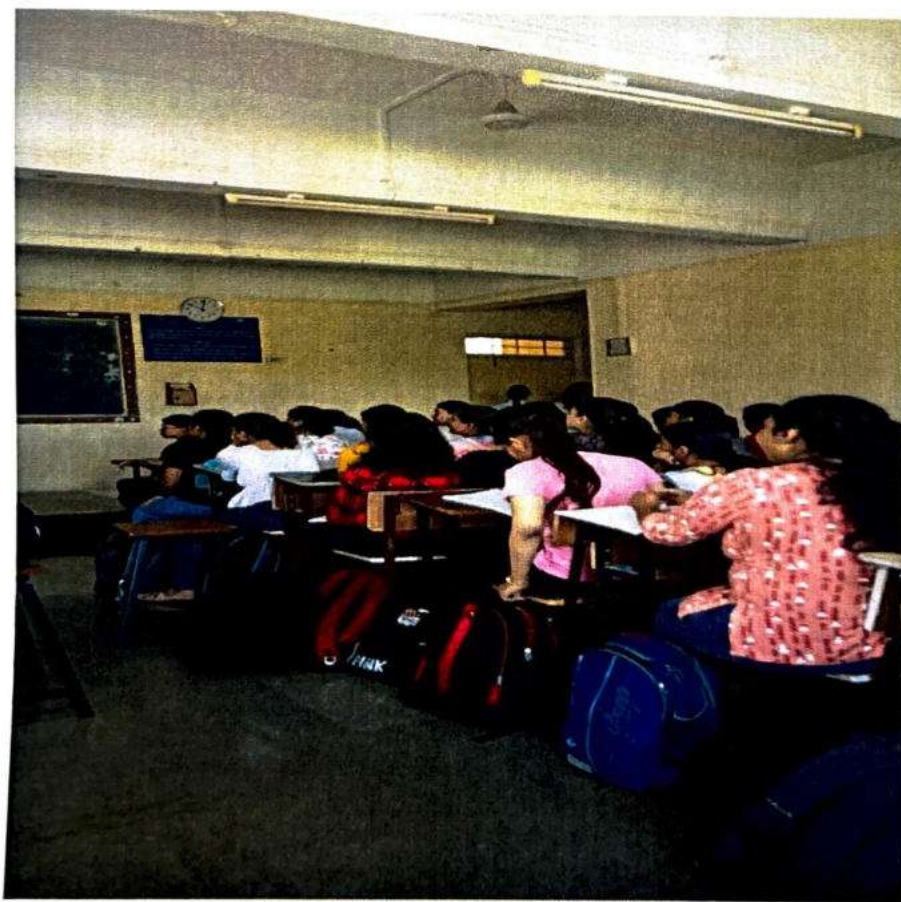

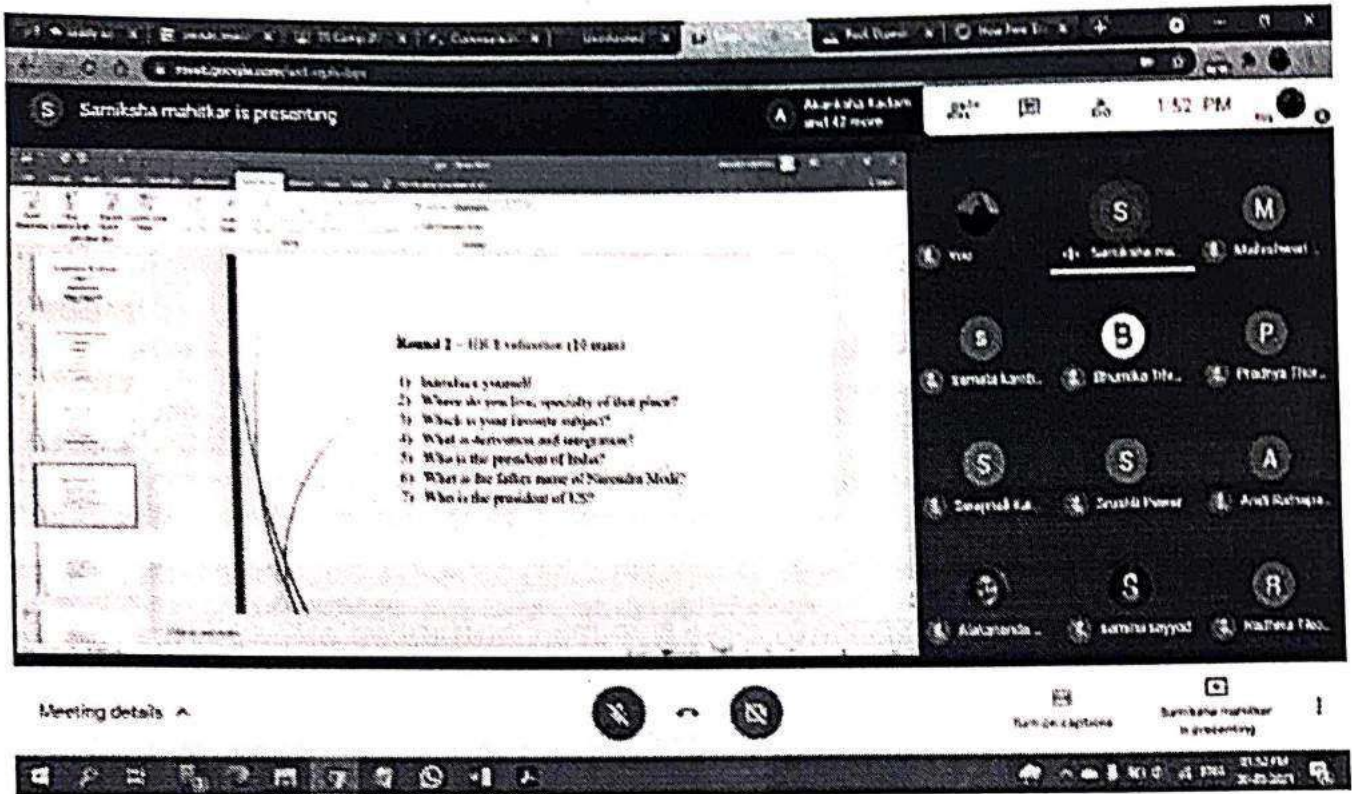
It was a 2 days training, where, on the first day, placed students made TE students aware about various rounds such as,


Peer-to-Peer Training Report
