Resolved & appreciated.

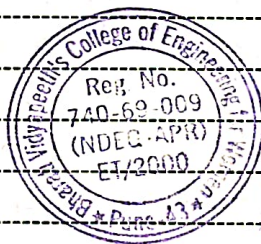

Resolved: Chairman guided the college members for admission process.

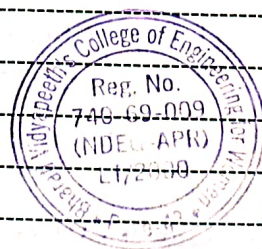

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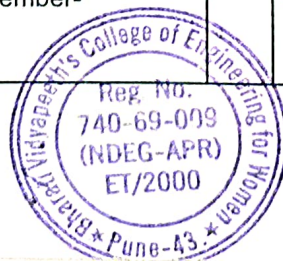

- Prof. Dr. D.A. Gadke presented faculty and students achievements report.

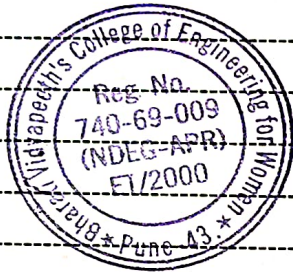
- The committee was informed about the semester-wise e-newsletter that reflects technical activities and achievements of the college, faculty and students.

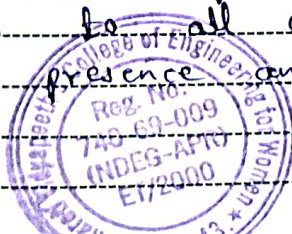

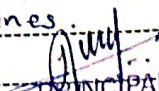

Prof. Dr. Pradeep Jadhav presented the plan of academic autonomy of the Institute.

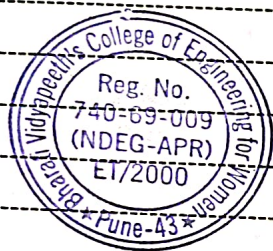
Resolution: Chairman provided guidelines.

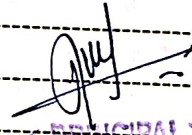
(B) College new Website
