On 1st February 2025, BVCOEW, Pune, in collaboration with SPPU Pune and the School of Martial Arts, Pune, organized a One Day Self Defence Workshop under Nirbhaya kanya scheme of SPPU, Pune. The goal of the workshop was to educate students of bvcoew, pune on the significance of self-defence and equip them with practical skills to protect themselves in potentially dangerous situations. The event began at 9:00 AM with a welcome address by Dr. S. S. Khan, followed by a speech from Prof. K.R. Chaudhari, Student Development Officer (SDO), who emphasized the importance of self-defence in today's world. Prof. K.R. Chaudhari expressed how such workshops can play a pivotal role in promoting safety, especially for women and individuals vulnerable to attack. The Chief Guest and Resource Person, Mr. Vikas Badhade, was introduced by Prof. U.S. Zope. Mr. Badhade is the founder of the School of Martial Arts in Pune and has years of experience in martial arts training and self-defence education. Principal Prof. Dr. Pradeep V. Jadhav then felicitated Mr. Badhade, honoring his contribution to the martial arts community.

In his opening remarks, Prof. Dr. Pradeep V. Jadhav encouraged all attendees to participate actively in the upcoming self-defence training session and highlighted the importance of being prepared for unexpected situations. The primary focus of the workshop was the self-defence training session, conducted by Mr. Vikas Badhade and his team of expert trainers from the School of Martial Arts. This session lasted from 9:55 AM to 1:00 PM and provided attendees with hands-on training in various self-defence techniques.

Self Defence Training Session: Mr. Badhade and his team began the session by explaining the basics of self-defence, emphasizing the significance of awareness, body language, and confidence in preventing and handling potential attacks. The trainers guided participants through a series of techniques that could be applied in real-life situations.

The session was divided into several practical exercises:

Defensive Postures and Stances: The trainers began by teaching participants how to adopt a strong, defensive stance. This posture ensures that an individual is in a position to defend themselves while minimizing the risk of being overpowered. The trainers demonstrated how to stand firm and maintain balance while being aware of surroundings.







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Escape Techniques: One of the key aspects of the workshop was teaching participants how to escape from various holds or grabs. The trainers demonstrated techniques for breaking free from wrist grabs, chokeholds, and other common physical restraints. Participants practiced these techniques in pairs, allowing them to become more comfortable with the movements and apply them effectively if needed.

Strikes and Counterattacks: The trainers demonstrated a variety of strikes such as knee strikes, elbow strikes, and punches. They also taught how to use the body's natural weapons, such as the knees, elbows, and feet, to defend against attackers. The focus was on targeting vulnerable areas of the body, such as the nose, eyes, groin, and knees. Participants practiced these strikes on pads held by trainers, ensuring they understood the proper techniques and felt confident executing them.

Defending Against Armed Attacks: The trainers also addressed the possibility of being attacked with weapons. Mr. Badhade demonstrated how to defend against knife and stick attacks using quick, decisive movements to disarm the attacker. Participants were shown how to use their surroundings to their advantage and how to create distance from an armed assailant.

Situational Awareness: Beyond physical techniques, the trainers stressed the importance of situational awareness. This involves staying alert to one's surroundings, recognizing potential threats, and avoiding risky situations whenever possible. Participants were encouraged to trust their instincts and take proactive steps to stay safe.

Throughout the session, Mr. Badhade and his team encouraged participants to ask questions, demonstrate techniques, and offer feedback. The hands-on approach allowed participants to gain confidence and experience in applying self-defence techniques, making the session both practical and empowering.

The trainers also provided valuable tips on building mental resilience, remaining calm under pressure, and knowing when to fight back or escape. The emphasis was not just on physical strength, but on the ability to use one's mind and body together to stay safe.

The session concluded with a final practice round, where participants were given the opportunity to combine the various techniques they had learned in a simulated self-defense scenario. This allowed them to assess their understanding and gain more confidence in their ability to defend themselves if necessary.

The workshop concluded at 1:00 PM with a vote of thanks by Prof. Pallavi Narkhede, who expressed her gratitude to Mr. Badhade and his team for their expert guidance and to all participants for their active involvement.

The One Day Self Defence Workshop was a resounding success. The practical self-defense training







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provided by Mr. Vikas Badhade and his team equipped participants with invaluable skills and boosted their confidence in handling potentially dangerous situations. The hands-on nature of the workshop ensured that participants gained not only theoretical knowledge but also the practical experience needed to apply these techniques effectively.

The workshop fostered a sense of empowerment among the participants, and the collaboration between BVCOEW, SPPU Pune, and the School of Martial Arts, Pune, proved to be a strong foundation for such an important initiative. This event has undoubtedly made a significant contribution to promoting safety and well-being in the community.

The hands-on Workshop on Skill Development was conducted from 20th February 2025 to 22nd February 2025 under the guidance of the Board of Student Development, Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU). The primary objective of the workshop was to provide hands-on training to students in Printed Circuit Board (PCB) making and Power Supply design. The workshop also emphasized the importance of e-scrap utilization and recycling techniques, fostering an eco-friendly approach to electronics design and sustainability.

This workshop was aimed at equipping students with technical skills that are crucial for their future careers in electronics and electrical engineering. It provided an opportunity for students to gain industry-relevant expertise and understand the significance of sustainable practices in electronics.

Workshop Highlights:

Expert Guidance: The workshop was led by industry professionals, Mr. Shubham Ubale and Mr. Mahesh Adsule, both experienced R&D engineers, along with a team of 12 trainees who provided hands-on demonstrations and mentorship.

Practical Demonstrations: Students worked on various tools and software for PCB designing, circuit testing, and troubleshooting to ensure efficiency in their designs.







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Workshop Activities:

Introduction to PCB Designing and Manufacturing: Students were introduced to the basics of circuit board design, including schematic creation and layout design using software.

- 1.Power Supply Design Principles: Experts explained the working principles of power supply circuits, their applications, and how to design reliable and efficient power sources.
- 2.Practical Session on PCB Fabrication: Students learned how to convert their theoretical designs into physical PCBs using etching and soldering techniques.
- 3.Utilization of E-Scrap for Component Extraction and Reuse: The workshop demonstrated the process of salvaging electronic components from e-waste, making the learning process cost-effective and environmentally friendly.
- 4.Testing and Troubleshooting of Designed Circuits: After assembling their PCBs, students performed functional tests and troubleshooting exercises to ensure the efficiency of their circuits.
- 5.Interactive Q&A and Problem-Solving Sessions: Experts addressed students' queries and provided guidance on overcoming common challenges in circuit design and fabrication.

Outcome of the Workshop:


