Ragging is strictly prohibited inside and outside the college campus. Actions to be taken against students indulging and abetting in Ragging as per the Directions of Hon'ble Supreme court of India. MAHARASHTRA ACT NO. XXXIII OF 1999, THE MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1999. (As modified up to the 29th August 2012)

- Debarring from appearing in any sessional test/university examination or withholding results.
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension from the college for a period of one month.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.

- Cancellation of admission.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- Fine up to twenty-five thousand rupees.
- Imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both.
- Collective punishment – When the students committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

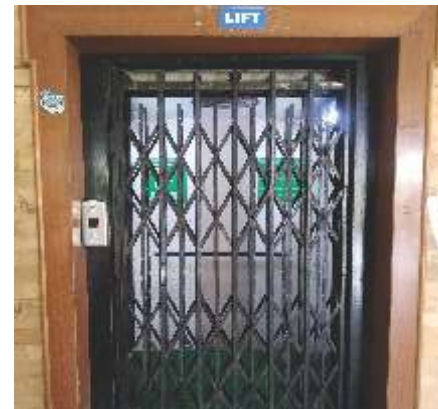
