




## Report

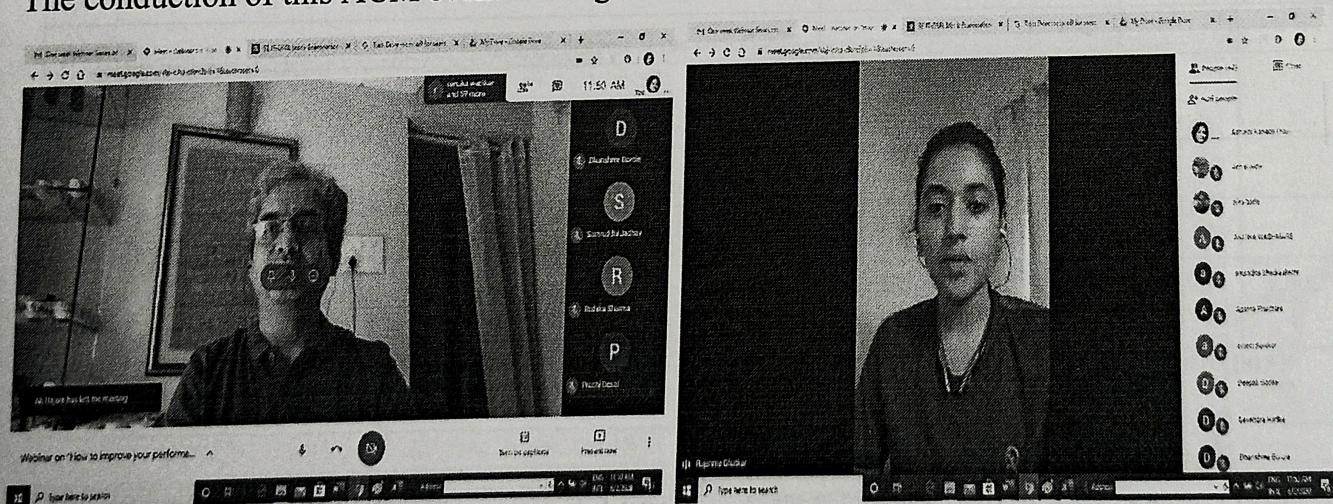
**Report of Webinar on "How to improve your performance in campus drive tests and interviews"**

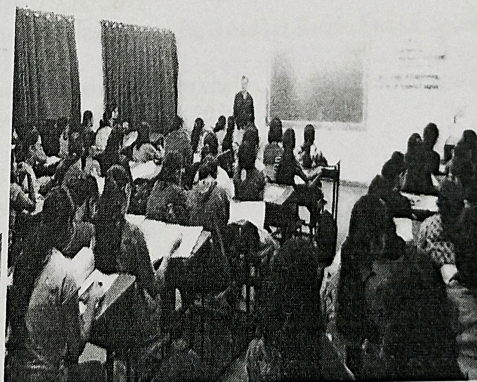
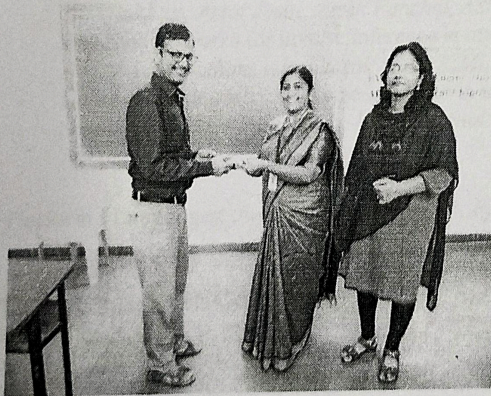
**Report of Seminar on "Machine Learning and its Applications"**



**Report of Seminar on "Digital Marketing"**

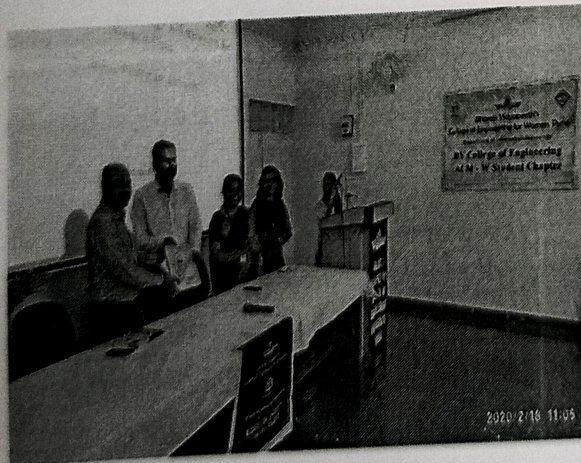

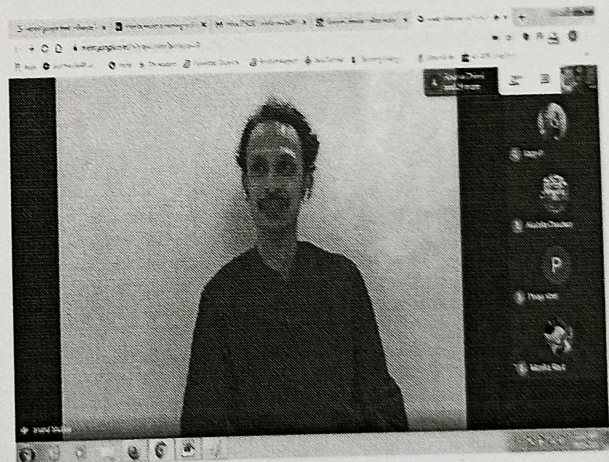
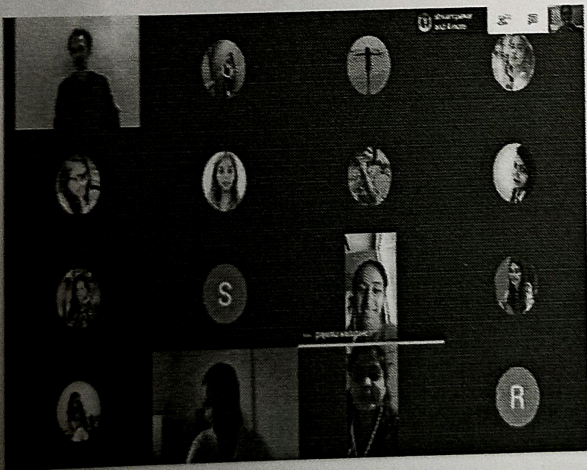
Webinar Topic: "Let's Talk Animation"
