
We conducted different activities as follows:



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



'Peer-to-Peer Training' for "Awareness Programme regarding Placement" Report

The peer-to-peer training for the students was scheduled on 13th May, 2023 in classroom 205. All placed BE IT students formed 5 groups for giving guidance to the TE students. BE students prepared presentations covering these topics in detail.

## **Coding Round Session:**

To ensure that students understand the importance of coding rounds and are well-prepared for them this 'Code to Code' session was conducted.

An introductory session was conducted to explain the purpose and structure of the program. This session covered the reasons why employers value aptitude tests and how they help assess candidates' suitability for specific roles.

TE students were made aware about the aspects of coding round which assess the candidate's adaptability, creativity, and capacity to think outside the box, qualities highly valued in the technology industry. Students were provided insights into the types of coding problems typically encountered, tips for effective preparation, and strategies to improve problem-solving skills. The access to online coding platforms and resources were discussed as a further supplement in their preparation. These platforms offer coding challenges, practice problems, and tutorials that help students improve their coding skills. BE students recommended specific platforms and resources that have proven helpful during their own preparation.

Peer-to-peer training significantly contributed to enhancing students' understanding of coding rounds and equipping them with the necessary knowledge and skills to excel in these assessments.

## **Aptitude Session:**

An introductory session was conducted to explain the purpose and structure of the program. This session covered the reasons why employers value aptitude tests and how they help assess candidates' suitability for specific roles.

Students were made aware of the essential skills and competencies evaluated through aptitude tests. This may include logical reasoning, numerical ability, verbal reasoning, critical thinking, problem-solving, and data interpretation. Real-life examples and case studies were also used to illustrate the relevance of these skills in professional settings. TE students were introduced with effective strategies and techniques to improve their performance in aptitude tests. This involved discussing time management, question prioritization, eliminating wrong answer choices, and utilizing shortcut methods where applicable. TE students collaborated and shared resources, discussed challenging topics, and issues they face while solving aptitude questions.

#### HR Interview:

To ensure that students understand the importance of HR rounds and are well-prepared for them this 'HR Interview' session was conducted.

An introductory session was conducted to explain the purpose and structure of the program. This session covered the reasons why employers value personality- strengths, weaknesses and how they help assess candidates' suitability for specific roles.

TE students were made aware about the aspects of behavior prowess which assess the candidate's adaptability, creativity, and how the candidate can fit into the company's work culture. Students were provided insights into the types of HR questions typically encountered, tips for effective preparation, and strategies to improve communication skills. The access to online preparation platforms and resources were discussed as a further supplement in their preparation. These platforms offer various types of HR questions, personality tests, etc. BE students recommended specific platforms and resources that have proven helpful during their own preparation.

Some common Questions mentioned were:

- 1. Tell me about yourself?
- 2. Why do you want to work for our company?
- 3. What are your greatest strengths and weaknesses?
- 4. How would you rate yourself on a scale from 1 to 10?
- 5. What is your biggest achievement so far?
- 6. Where do you see yourself in 5 years?
- 7. Why should we hire you?

#### Technical Interview:

This session provided practical tips and strategies for tackling technical interview questions, coding challenges, and other aspects of the technical round. The guidance on how to approach problem-solving, effective coding practices, and common pitfalls to avoid were given.

BE students presented PPTs on preparation strategies for the Technical Round. This includes topics like data structures, algorithms, object-oriented programming, databases, operating systems, and networking. Online resources, textbooks, and peer-recommended study materials helped TE students for comprehensive understanding of preparation. Students were made aware about how communication skills, and technical proficiency can significantly enhance their performance during the actual interview. BE students also provided some valuable advice to stay informed about the latest trends, tools, and technologies in their field of interest. Being up to date with industry-specific knowledge demonstrates a proactive attitude and eagerness to learn, which can impress interviewers during the technical round.

In conclusion, this session offered a valuable opportunity for TE students to enhance their preparation for the technical round of placement interviews. By leveraging the knowledge, experiences, and support of their peers, students gained the confidence, skills, and insights required to excel in technical interviews.

### **Company Wise Hiring Trends:**

In this session students were provided with the company-specific preparation strategies for placement. BE students shared their experiences, insights, and strategies with their fellow students.

BE students presented different company-specific preparation strategies which involved researching the company, understanding its culture, values, and industry, and aligning one's skills and experiences with the company's requirements. These strategies enabled students to showcase their suitability and stand out among other applicants. The one placed student from each company of BE IT had given a presentation on the recruitment process of each company. The hiring trends in companies like Amdocs, Capgemini, Cimpress, VOIS, NilsenIQ and Persistent were explained by BE IT students. Students were aware of the must to points to prepare for the specific company they are in: researching the company thoroughly, studying the company's website, annual reports, news articles, and industry trends. BE students shared their interview experiences, including the types of questions asked, interview formats, and specific competencies assessed. They guided students on how to create and maintain a professional online presence and shared their networking strategies and provided tips for building a strong personal brand. The last session ended with the Q&A session and verbal feedback.

By conducting this session students gained practical insights from their peers who have successfully navigated the placement process recently. This enabled students to tailor their preparation strategies according to specific companies.

Questions asked in the technical round were discussed. What are the important points to consider while giving technical interviews were fully explained by BE IT students. How to solve the particular questions into the given time period.

Further, they elaborated how every company conducts an HR interview round to judge your personality, your strengths, your weaknesses, your capability to handle the role, to check your background, and to understand if you're the right fit for this job. The guidance for general questions like Tell me about yourself, why are you interested in this position? Were given.

The Code To Code session included demonstration of online programming platforms like Hackerrank , Code Chef, Geeks for Geeks, Prepinsta , LeetCode etc. for logic development and programming practice. These sessions were indeed useful for SE students for the preparation of Company placement.

In the Company specific session, the one placed student from each company of BE IT has given a presentation on the recruitment process of each particular company. The hiring trends in companies like Amdocs, Capgemini, Cimpress, VOIS, NilsenIQ and Persistent were explained by BE IT students. Also the general questions were asked by SE students and they were answered by BE IT students.
